

## C. Scenic Line Post (SLP) required.

The straight section of the deck requires a Scenic Line Post (SLP) installed in line with the edge of the deck.

## D. Scenic Corner Post (SCP) required

The corner of the deck at this point is 110°/70°. Use a Scenic Corner Post (SCP) installed with the baseplate turned evenly in the middle of the angle. This will split the angle into two 10° angles from each side of the post.

## E. Scenic Wall Post (SWP) required.

Since this angle is only 20° from the wall, use a Scenic Wall Post (SWP) mounted flush against the wall. A Scenic Wall Post allows for angles up to 22.5° left or right.

When Scenic Railing is being used as a guardrail, do not exceed the 48" center to center spacing as this is outside our engineering spec and is at the end users own risk and could result in a failed inspection. It is the sole responsibility of the home owner/contractor to comply with local building codes.
